VIII	<p><u>Amendments</u></p> <p>Active members can suggest changes to bylaws by contacting President. President to propose changes to Bylaws Committee for review & approval. If approved by committee, proposal will go to members for approval. Proposal must go out 20 days in advance of meeting.</p>	<p>Allows amendments to Club bylaws by vote of members.</p> <p>Current article does not provide bylaws committee & associated process.</p>	June 2008
X	<p><u>Philanthropies</u></p> <p>Committee membership of 7 with representation from the Board and general members.</p> <p>Philanthropic distributions are generally made two times a year. Any emergency requests for donations must be submitted to the Philanthropy Committee.
